

# Power Wheel Rules & Registration Info

Hamilton County Speedway

**Participation:** Power Wheels division is open to boys & girls, ages three (3) to eight (8) years old.

**Safety Gear & Attire:** Participants will be required to wear (at minimum) a bicycle helmet, closed toe shoes (tennis shoes or boots, NO flip flops), and eye protection. Swim goggles are approved.

## Vehicles:

- Stock Power Wheels only.
- Competitors body must be fully contained in the vehicle.
- Vehicles where the legs are on the outside (4-wheelers) are not allowed.
- 12V system or a 12V car battery will be allowed. It must be fastened securely.
- Traction devices or studs are not allowed on tires.
- Doors need to be fastened shut. Pro-tip: Riveted patches look very cool!
- Fake stacks ARE allowed and look authentic as well.
- NO bumpers, weights, or anything to reinforce the vehicle is allowed.
- The vehicles will need a number on each side.
- It must be big enough to cover an 8 ½ x 11 sheet of paper.
- You can put it in a page protector to help save it from mud and ripping.
- Or duct tape works great for numbers.

**Registration Fee:** There is no registration fee; however, you and your child will need to purchase a pit pass (\$30 for adults + \$15 for kid).

**Pit Rules:** Only one (1) parent or guardian is allowed in the Power Wheel Pit Area. Track officials will help get participants lined up for their race. You do not need to purchase a pit pass but at minimum you will need to purchase a grandstand ticket.

**Classes:** Depending on the number of entries, we will break classes into two groups; 3-5 year olds and 6-8 year olds.

## Registration:

- Registration is limited to the first twenty-five (25) entries.
- You can call the Hamilton County Speedway office to register your child, (515) 832-6000.
- Office hours are Monday – Friday, 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM.
- There is no registration fee; however, parent and/or guardian + child will need to purchase a pit pass.

## Day of the Race:

- Power Wheel can be parked in the Power Wheel Pit Area.

- Drivers meeting at 5:00 PM in the Power Wheel Pit area.
- Competitors will not be allowed to driver the power wheel around the pit area.
- Vehicle needs to be carried to the track.
- Competitors will hot lap at 5:15 PM.
- Line up will be random draw.
- Feature lineup will begin approximately at 5:30.
- Competitors will be announced.
- Each feature will be five (5) laps.
- Parents will not be allowed to step on the track.
- Please coach your child from the Power Wheel Pit Area.
- Safety + track officials will be on the track.

Awards:

- At the completion of each feature, every competitor will receive \$10 cash.
- Each winner will receive a trophy and a t-shirt.

Please remember this is a fun event. We want your child to have a good time. Don't ruin it.
