

# Hawkeye 600 Driver Information

- The Hawkeye 600 will take place Friday and Saturday, June 25-26, at the Hamilton County Speedway in Webster City, Iowa.
- Race distance is 300 laps each night with standing starts and restarts.
- \$10,000 to win each night. Payouts through 20th. Purse is independent each night.
- \$5,000 bonus for the best average finishing position between both nights.
- Purse is paid out each night once results are official at pit shack.
- RV parking/camping is available in the BACK pit area only. Everybody camping must have a pit pass. Camping sites with electric hookups are available. Camping is \$20 per night. Drivers/fans can contact Jamie at (515) 832-1443 to reserve a spot. Anyone camping in the secondary pit area will pay. No camping on the infield..
- Hamilton County Speedway has concessions, bathrooms and a catwalk in the pit area.
- Out-of-town travelers can show up Thursday after 12 noon. If you need to show up early or will be showing up late on Thursday, call Todd Staley at (515) 297-3870.
- Infield parking for both days is \$50 for dirt spots or \$100 for cement spots. There are 140 spots in the main pit and remainder will pit outside turns 1-2. All pit parking is on a first-come, first-served basis. If spots are available on race day, you can purchase at the pit gate.
- Infield parking closes at 5:00 p.m. Friday and Saturday. For track prep purposes, there will be no vehicle traffic to the infield after 5:00 p.m. each night. NO EXCEPTIONS
- Mandatory drivers meeting each day at 5:00 p.m. (at catwalk).
- Mandatory scorers meeting each day at 5:30 p.m. (at catwalk).
- Each scorers MUST have a pit pass. One (1) scorer is required for each car. Video loops are used to verify score cards.
- Cars line up each night at 5:45 p.m. WE START ON TIME
- The event will be broadcast live online at [RacinDirt.com](http://RacinDirt.com). Tell your friends and family that can't make it to tune in live.
- RACEceivers are not required but are STRONGLY encouraged.
- No cautions. The race stops only for cars blocking most of the track, fires, flips, safety concerns or major accidents. Red flag will be displayed.
- Pitting is allowed. Driver changes are allowed. Rules are all safety related.
